## Production Chemist Responsibilities

- assisting with fork lift truck loading and cylinder packaging for despatch
- scheduling and managing maintenance visits for vacuum equipment, gas pressure lines and gas monitoring equipment

- assisting the Quality Manager with the continual development and improvement of the quality system
- assisting the Health and Safety Manager in the development of environment, health and safety procedures including ADR/CDG transport regulations and cylinder storage
